

NEW PATH AT SACHELL LANE, PARISH OF HOUND

On 18th November 2014 Hampshire County Council entered into a Deed of Dedication which created a new footpath varying between 1.2 metres and 1.5 metres in width, commencing at a junction with Satchell Lane (GR475085) (near Hamble-le-Rice but in the Parish of Hound) and proceeding in a north easterly direction to a junction with Hound Bridleway 9 (GR477086) a total distance of approximately 220 metres. Each year Hampshire County Council update the Definitive Map by means of a Legal Event Order and this path was added by the Order made on 31 March 2015 and it is now Footpath 504 in the Parish of Hound. You will find it on the on-line mapping at <http://www.hants.gov.uk/rh/row/maps/1207.pdf> In August 2015 the path was cleared of undergrowth and signposted where it leaves Satchell Lane and is now in use.
